The EVPs & Managing Directors will be supported from Corporate Sustainability & Compliance, the Sustainability Team and relevant global or regional functions.

Compliance to this policy and local legal obligations regarding Environmental Protection are regularly monitored by the Group Management, the Interroll Corporate Sustainability & Compliance Organization and randomly checked during Compliance Audits.
